

Annual report of ATIC 2013-14

Executive summary

The seven hundred and fifty eight visitors visited ATIC during the period, which includes farmers, Govt. employees, NGO, private companies officials etc. A revenue of Rs. 64, 366 was generated through ATIC during 2013-14.

Achievements:

- **Queries-** The hundred and nine phone calls were made by the farmers, dairy owners, land developers, Govt. and private companies for asking their problems.
- **Selling of products-** Seed materials of different fodder crops, literature, earth worms, feed pellets etc. were sold through ATIC and revenue for Rs. 64, 366 was collected.
- Literature available at ATIC was issued for e- chara library at Garera, Datia, NICRA project and for many farmers fairs including Krishi Vasant at Nagpur.
- Farmers Scientific Co-ordination committee meets every Wednesday at ATIC, in which farmers got the solution of their eagerness by taking part in the meeting.
